CHARTER OF THE LABOR PARTY OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA (Proposal 2024)

PREAMBLE

We understand that we, as members of this esteemed party, have a sacred duty to not only uphold justice and democracy but also to actively work towards creating a society where every individual is treated with respect and dignity.

The essence of our existence lies in reimagining the political landscape and building a new representative democratic state solely focused on safeguarding the rights, liberties, and prosperity of all Nigerian people. We are guided by one fundamental truth – the lives of our citizens are precious gifts from God, underscoring their inherent worth and importance.

Any political system or leaders who fail to recognize and honor this truth through their actions does not deserve to govern or represent the Nigerian people. Together, let us strive towards a future where every Child of the Land can flourish and thrive in a just society built on compassion, integrity, and equality.

PARTY PLATFORM

- To secure Nigeria, end banditry and insurgency, and unite our dear nation, to manage our diversity such that no one is left behind.
- To shift emphasis from consumption to production by running a production-centered economy that is driven by an agrarian revolution and export-oriented industrialization.
- To restructure the polity through effective legal and institutional reforms to entrench the rule of law, aggressively fight corruption, reduce cost of governance, and establish an honest and efficient civil service.

**ARTICLE ONE
The Labor Party Of The Federal Republic of Nigeria**

The Labor Party of the Federal Republic of Nigeria shall:

Section 1. Nominate and assist in the election of Labor Party candidates for the offices of President and Vice President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria;

Section 2. Adopt and promote statements of policy;

Section 3. Assist state and local Labor Party organizations in the election of their candidates and the education of their voters;

Section 4. Establish standards and rules of procedure to afford all members of the Labor Party full, timely, and equal opportunities to participate in decisions concerning the selection of candidates, the formulation of policy, and the conduct of other Party affairs, without prejudice based on religion, tribe, age (if of voting age), economic status, gender, ethnic identity or disability, and further, to promote fair campaign practices and the fair adjudication of disputes. Accordingly, the scheduling of Labor Party affairs at all levels shall consider the presence of any religious persuasion of significant numbers of concentration whose level of participation would be affected;

Section 5. Raise and disburse monies needed for the successful operation of the Labor Party;

Section 6. Work with Labor Party public officials at all levels to realize the Labor Party Platform; and

Section 7. Encourage and support codes of political ethics that embody substantive rules of ethical guidance for public officials and employees in federal, state, and local governments, to assure that public officials shall at all times conduct themselves in a manner that reflects creditably upon the office they serve, shall not use their office to gain special privileges and benefits and shall refrain from acting in their official capacities when their independence of judgment would be adversely affected by personal interest or duties.

**ARTICLE TWO
National Convention**

Section 1. The Labor Party shall assemble in the National Convention in each year in which an election for office of President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria is held.

Section 2. The National Convention shall be the highest authority of the Labor Party, subject to the provisions of this Charter. The National Convention shall recognize the state and other Parties entitled to participate in the conduct of the national affairs of the Labor Party, including its conventions, conferences and committees. State Party rules or state laws relating to the election of delegates to the National Convention shall be observed unless in conflict with this Charter and other provisions adopted pursuant to the authority of the Charter, including the resolutions or other actions of the National Convention. In the event of such conflict with state laws, state Parties shall be required to take provable positive steps to bring such laws into conformity and to carry out such other measures as may be required by the National Convention or the Labor Party National Committee.

Section 3. The National Convention shall nominate a candidate for the office of President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, nominate a candidate for the office of Vice President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, adopt a platform and act upon such other matters as it deems appropriate.

Section 4. The National Convention shall be composed of delegates as defined in the Labor Party National Committee Charter, Article Nine, Section 15. The delegates shall be chosen through processes which:

- A. assure all Labor Party voters a full, timely, and equal opportunity to participate,
- B. assure that delegations fairly reflect the division of preferences expressed by those who participate in the Presidential nominating process,
- C. do not deny participation for failure to pay a cost, fee or poll tax,
- D. allow participation in good faith by all voters who are members of the Labor Party and, to the extent determined by a State Party to be in the interests of the Labor Party in that State, by voters who are not registered or affiliated with any party; and
- E. except with respect to persons referred to in Section 5(c) of this Article, begin within the calendar year of the Convention provided, however, that fairly apportioned and openly selected state Party Committees, elected no earlier than the date of the previous presidential election, shall not be precluded from selecting such portion of their respective state delegations, according to the standards provided in this Charter and the Bylaws and the Delegate Selection Rules, as may be specifically authorized by the Labor Party National Committee in the Call to the Convention,
- F. prohibit unpledged and uncommitted delegates, except delegates or alternates expressing an uncommitted preference shall be permitted to be elected at the local government level, in which event, if such preference meets the applicable threshold and qualifies for at-large or similar delegates or alternates, such at-large or similar delegates or alternates shall be allocated to that uncommitted preference as if it were a presidential candidate,
- G. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in this section, the following rules shall apply:
 - a. All members of the Labor National Committee shall serve as unpledged delegates.
 - b. The following individuals shall be permitted to serve as unpledged delegates:

- i. The President and Vice President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, if they are Labor Party members.
- ii. The Labor Party members of the Federal Republic of Nigeria Senate and the House of Representatives.
- iii. The Labor Party Governors.
- iv. Former Labor Party Presidents and Vice Presidents of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.
- v. Former Labor Party Majority and Minority Leaders of the Federal Republic of Nigeria Senate.
- vi. Former Labor Party Speakers and Minority Leaders of the Federal Republic of Nigeria House of Representatives.
- vii. Former Chairs of the Labor Party National Committee.
- viii. Note that these delegates shall not be permitted to have alternates and shall constitute an exception to Subsection (b) of this Section 4.

Section 5. The delegate vote allocable to each state shall be determined as provided in the Bylaws, consistent with the formula:

- A. giving equal weight to population, which may be measured by electoral vote, and to the Labor Party vote in elections for the office of the President; and
- B. giving such additional delegate votes as may be specifically designated by the Labor Party National Committee in the Call to the Convention, subject to such conditions as may be set forth by the Labor National Committee in said Call, for the purpose of providing incentives for scheduling the event constituting the first determining stage in the presidential nominating process in each state later in the year of the Convention than such event would otherwise be scheduled in the absence of such incentive; and
- C. which shall also provide additional delegate positions to members of the Labor Party National Committee; and
- D. which may also provide additional delegate positions to Labor Party elected public officials specifically designated by the Labor Party National Committee in the Call to the Convention, subject to the provisions of Section 4.

**ARTICLE THREE
Labor Party National Committee**

Section 1. The Labor Party National Committee shall have general responsibility for the affairs of the Labor Party between National Conventions, subject to the provisions of this Charter and to the resolutions or other actions of the National Convention. This responsibility shall include:

- A. issuing the Call to the National Convention;
- B. conducting the Party's Presidential campaign;
- C. filling vacancies in the nominations for the office of President and Vice President;
- D. formulating and disseminating statements of Party policy and platform;

- E. providing for the election or appointment of a Chairperson, Six Vice Zonal Chairpersons, one of whom shall be the President of the Association of State Labor Committees and one of whom shall be the Vice Chairperson for Civic Engagement and Voter Participation, a Treasurer, a Secretary, and a National Finance Chair, who, with the exception of the Chairperson, shall be as equally divided as practicable according to geo-political zones at the quadrennial election, as defined in the Labor Party National Committee Charter, Article Nine, Section 16, and for the filling of vacancies that occur outside of the regularly scheduled elections of the President of the Association of State Labor Party Committees, all following Rules of Procedure adopted by the Labor Party National Committee; and other appropriate officers who shall be as equally divided as practicable according to geo-political zones; and
- F. all other actions necessary or appropriate in order to carry out the provisions of this Charter and the objectives of the Labor Party.

Section 2. The Labor National Committee shall be composed of:

- A. the Chairperson and the highest-ranking officer of another gender of each recognized state Labor Party;
- B. two hundred and eighteen additional members apportioned to the states on the basis set forth in Article Two, Section 5(a) of the Charter, consistent with the full participation goals of Sections 3 and 4 of Article Eight of the Charter; provided that each state shall have at least two such additional members;
- C. the Chairperson of the Labor Party Governors' Association and two additional governors, as selected by the Association;
- D. the Labor Party Leader in the Federal Republic of Nigeria Senate and the Labor Leader in the Federal Republic of Nigeria House of Representatives and one additional member of each body, who shall be of another gender of, and appointed by, the respective leaders;
- E. the Executive Chairperson, the Six Zonal Vice Chairpersons, the National Finance Chair, the Treasurer, the National Youth Leader, the National Women's Leader, and the Secretary of the Labor Party National Committee;
- F. the Chairperson of the National Conference of Labor Party Local Government Chairpersons and two additional Local Government Chairpersons, at least one of whom shall be of another gender of the Chairperson, as selected by the Conference;
- G. the President of the Youth Association of Labor Party of Nigeria and two additional members, at least one of whom shall be of another gender as the President, as selected by the organization biennially in convention assembled;
- H. the Chairperson of the Labor Party Legislative Campaign Committee and two additional state legislators, at least one of whom shall be of another gender as the Chairperson, as selected by the Committee;
- I. the Chairperson of the National Labor Party Zonal Committee and two additional Zonal officials, at least one of whom shall be of another gender as the Chairperson, as selected by the Conference;

- J. the President of the National Federation of Labor Party Women and two additional members selected by the Federation;
- K. the President of the Nigerian Students of the Labor Party and the Vice President, who shall be of another gender, as elected by the organization annually;
- L. the Chairperson of the National Association of Labor Party State Treasurers and the Vice Chair who shall be of another gender, as selected by the Association;
- M. the Chairperson of the National Association of Labor Party Lieutenant Governors and the Vice Chair who shall be of another gender, as selected by the Association;
- N. the Chairperson of the Labor Party Association of State Secretaries and the Vice Chair who shall be of another gender, as selected by the Association;
- O. the Chairperson of the Labor Party Association of Legal Practitioners and one additional attorney who shall be of another gender of the Chairperson, as selected by the Association;
- P. the Chairperson of the Labor Party Association of Market Women and one additional member, as selected by the Association;
- Q. the Chairperson of National Unions Coordinating Committee, who is not otherwise a member of the Labor Party National Committee and one additional member, who shall be of another gender, as selected by the Coordinating Committee;
- R. the Chairperson of Traditional Leaders Coordinating Committee, who is not otherwise a member of the Labor Party National Committee and one additional member, who shall be of another gender, as selected by the Coordinating Committee;
- S. the Chairperson of the National Labor Party Elders and Founders Coordinating Council, who is not otherwise a member of the Labor Party National Committee and one additional member, who shall be of another gender, as selected by the Coordinating Council;
- T. the Chairperson of the Secondary School Prefects For Labor Party of Nigeria and a Vice Chairperson, who shall be of the opposite gender, as elected by the organization annually;
- U. the Chairperson of the National Labor Congress, who is not otherwise a member of the Labor Party National Committee and one additional member, who shall be of another gender, as selected by the Coordinating Committee;
- V. the Chairperson of the Big Tent, who is not otherwise a member of the Labor Party National Committee and one additional member, who shall be of another gender, as selected by the Coordinating Committee;
- W. additional members as provided in Article Nine of this Charter. No more than seventy-five additional members of the Labor Party National Committee may be added by the foregoing members.

Section 3. Members of the Labor Party National Committee apportioned to the states and those provided for in Article Nine who are not otherwise members by virtue of Party office, shall be selected by each state Labor Party in accordance with standards as to participation established in the Bylaws of the Labor Party for terms commencing on the day the National Convention adjourns and terminating on the day the next Convention adjourns. Such members shall be selected during the calendar year in which a National Convention is held, through processes

which assure full, timely and equal opportunity to participate. Vacancies shall be filled by the state party as provided in the Bylaws. The members of the National Committee from each state shall be divided as equally as practicable between committeemen and committeewomen. Members of the Labor Party National Committee who serve by virtue of holding public or Party office shall serve on the Committee only during their terms in such office. Members of the Labor Party National Committee added by the other members shall serve a term that runs coterminously with the Chairperson of the Labor Party National Committee, through the election of the new Chairperson, and until their successors are chosen; members in this category shall have the right to vote for the new Chairperson. Members of the Labor Party National Committee who serve by virtue of holding state Party office shall be selected by such parties in accordance with standards as to participation established in Bylaws.

Section 4. The Bylaws may provide for removal of members of the Labor Party National Committee for cause by a two-thirds vote of the National Committee and may also require continued residence in the jurisdiction represented by the member and affirmative support for the Labor Party Presidential and Vice Presidential nominees as a condition of continued membership thereon. The Bylaws may further provide for a minimum level of attendance at National Committee meetings for Labor Party National Committee members. The Bylaws may establish that any member of the Labor Party National Committee who misses three consecutive meetings of the Labor Party National Committee has failed to meet the minimum level of attendance and is deemed to have resigned from the Labor Party National Committee.

Section 5. The Labor Party National Committee shall meet at least once each year. Meetings shall be called by the Chairperson, by the Executive Committee of the Labor Party National Committee, or by written request of no fewer than one-fourth of the members of the Labor Party National Committee.

**ARTICLE FOUR
Labor Party Executive Committee**

Section 1. There shall be an Executive Committee of the Labor Party National Committee, which shall be responsible for the conduct of the day-to-day affairs of the Labor Party subject to this Charter, the National Convention and the Labor Party National Committee.

Section 2. The Executive Committee shall be elected by and serve at the pleasure of the members of the Labor Party National Committee. The size, composition and term of office shall be determined by the Labor Party National Committee, provided that, the number of members elected by the congresses of members of the Labor Party National Committee shall be no fewer than twenty-four less than the number selected by other means.

Section 3. The Executive Committee shall meet at least four times each year. Meetings shall be called by the Chairperson or by written request of no fewer than one-fourth of its members. The

Executive Committee shall keep a record of its proceedings which shall be available to the public.

**ARTICLE FIVE
Labor Party National Chairperson**

Section 1. The National Chairperson of the Labor Party shall carry out the programs and policies of the National Convention and the Labor Party National Committee.

Section 2. The National Chairperson, the six Zonal Vice Chairpersons, the National Finance Chair, the Treasurer, the Secretary, the National Youth Leader, and the National Women's Leader shall be elected:

- A. at a meeting of the Labor Party National Committee held after the succeeding presidential election, and,
- B. whenever a vacancy occurs. The National Chairperson shall be elected and may be removed by a majority vote of the Labor Party National Committee, and each term shall expire upon the election for the following term.

Section 3. The National Chairperson shall preside over meetings of the Labor Party National Committee and of the Executive Committee. In the event of a vacancy in the office of the National Chairperson, the designated Vice Chair as provided for in Article Two, Section 12(b) of the Bylaws, or the next highest ranking officer of the National Committee present at the meeting shall preside.

Section 4. The National Chairperson shall serve full time and shall receive such compensation as may be determined by agreement between the Chairperson and the Labor Party National Committee. In the conduct and management of the affairs and procedures of the Labor Party National Committee, particularly as they apply to the preparation and conduct of the Presidential nomination process, the Chairperson shall exercise impartiality and evenhandedness as between the Presidential candidates and campaigns. The Chairperson shall be responsible for ensuring that the national officers and staff of the Labor Party National Committee maintain impartiality and evenhandedness during the Labor Party Presidential nominating process.

**ARTICLE SIX
Labor Party Conferences**

The Labor Party may hold a National Party Conference between National Conventions. The nature, agenda, composition, time, and place of the Party Conference shall be determined by the Labor Party National Committee.

**ARTICLE SEVEN
National Finance Organizations**

Section 1. The Labor Party National Committee shall establish National Finance Organizations which shall have general responsibility for the finances of the Labor Party. These National Finance Organizations shall raise funds to support the Labor Party and shall advise and assist state Labor Parties and candidates in securing funds for their purposes.

Section 2. The National Finance Chair shall be elected or approved by the Labor Party National Committee.

**ARTICLE EIGHT
Full Participation**

Section 1. The Labor Party of the Federal Republic of Nigeria shall be open to all who desire to support the Party and who wish to be known as Labor.

Section 2. Discrimination in the conduct of Labor Party affairs on the basis of age (if of voting age), tribe, ethnic origin, religion, economic status, gender, ethnic identity or disability is prohibited, to the end that the Labor Party at all levels be an open party.

Section 3. To encourage full participation by all Labor, with particular concern for ethnic and social minority groups, women, and youth in the delegate selection process and in all Party affairs, as defined in the Bylaws, the National and State Labor Parties shall adopt and implement a zoning formula which provides for representation as nearly as practicable of the aforementioned groups, as indicated by their presence in the Labor electorate. This program shall include specific goals and timetables to achieve this purpose.

Section 4. This goal shall not be accomplished either directly or indirectly by the national or state Labor Parties' imposition of mandatory quotas at any level of the delegate selection process or in any other Party affairs, as defined in the Bylaws; however, representation as nearly as practicable of geo-political zones, ethnic and social minority groups, women and youth, as indicated by their presence in the Labor electorate, as provided in this Article, shall not be deemed a quota.

Section 5. Performance under an approved zoning formula and composition of the Convention delegation shall be considered relevant evidence in the challenge of any state delegation. If a state Party has adopted and implemented an approved and monitored zoning formula, the Party

shall not be subject to challenge based solely on delegate composition or solely on primary results.

**ARTICLE NINE
General Provisions**

Section 1. Labor Party means the Labor Party of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

Section 2. The Bylaws shall provide for states in which the Labor Party nominee for President or electors committed to the nominee did not appear on the ballot in elections used for apportionment formulae.

Section 3. For the purposes of this Charter, the Federal Capital of Abuja shall be treated as a state containing the appropriate number of delegates.

Section 4. Recognized Labor Party organizations in areas not entitled to vote in Presidential elections may elect such voting delegates to National Conventions as the Labor Party National Committee provides in the Call to the Convention.

Section 6. Labor Party members Abroad shall have four votes on the Labor Party National Committee, which votes shall be shared by the Chairperson, the highest-ranking officer of another gender, three National Committeemen and three National Committeewomen except as may otherwise be provided by the Bylaws.

Section 7. The Bylaws shall provide for regional organizations of the Party.

Section 8. To assure that the Labor nominee for the office of President of the United States is selected by a fair and equitable process, the Labor Party National Committee may adopt such statements of policy as it deems appropriate with respect to the timing of Presidential nominating processes and shall work with state Parties to accomplish the objectives of such statements.

Section 9. The Labor Party National Committee shall maintain and publish a code of fair campaign practices, which shall be recommended for observance by all candidates campaigning as Labor. The Labor Party National Committee Chair shall put in place a code of Labor Party National Committee conduct concerning Presidential candidates and campaigns prior to each presidential cycle to ensure fairness and transparency. The code shall address areas including, but not limited to: providing information to campaigns; agreements between the Labor Party National Committee and campaigns; fundraising; and common vendors. This code

shall be made readily available to the Labor Party National Committee and all bona fide Labor Party presidential candidates.

Section 10. The Labor Party shall not require a delegate to a Party convention or congress to cast a vote contrary to his or her expressed preference.

Section 11. Voting by proxy shall not be permitted at the National Convention.

Section 12. All meetings of the Labor Party National Committee, the Executive Committee, and all other official Party committees, commissions and bodies shall be open to the public, and votes shall not be taken by secret ballot or indirect elections.

Section 13. The Labor Party National Committee shall prepare and make available to the public an annual report concerning the financial affairs of the Labor Party.

Section 14. The text of the Charter and the Bylaws, or portions thereof, shall be made available in other languages as needed upon reasonable request.

Section 15. Except as otherwise provided herein, the membership of the Labor Party National Committee, the Executive Committee, Labor Party state central committees, and all national official Party Conventions, committees, commissions, and like bodies shall be as equally divided as practicable between geo-political zones and senatorial districts. State Parties shall take provable positive steps to achieve legislative changes to bring the law into compliance with this provision wherever this provision conflicts with state statutes.

Section 16. Democratic Party Credo.
(Requires collective input)

ARTICLE TEN - Amendments, Bylaws, & Rules

Section 1. This Charter may be amended by a vote of a majority of all of the delegates to the National Convention, provided that no such amendment shall be effective unless and until it is subsequently ratified by a vote of the majority of the entire membership of the Labor Party National Committee. This Charter may also be amended by a vote of two-thirds of the entire membership of the Labor Party National Committee. At least thirty days written notice shall be given of any National Committee meeting at which action will be taken pursuant to this Section, and any proposed amendment shall be given to all members of the National Committee and shall be released to the national news media. This Charter may also be amended by a vote of two-thirds of the entire membership of any Labor Party Conference called under the authority of this Charter for such purpose.

Section 2. Bylaws of the Labor Party shall be adopted to provide for the governance of the affairs of the Labor Party in matters not provided for in this Charter. Bylaws may be adopted or amended by a majority vote of:

- A. the National Convention; or
- B. the Democratic National Committee provided that thirty days written notice of any proposed Bylaw or amendment has been given to all members of the National Committee.

Unless adopted in the form of an amendment to this Charter or otherwise designated, any resolution adopted by the National Convention relating to the governance of the Party shall be considered a Bylaw.

Section 3. Each official body of the Labor Party created under the authority of this Charter shall adopt and conduct its affairs in accordance with written rules, which rules shall be consistent with this Charter, the Bylaws and other provisions adopted pursuant to authority of the Charter, including resolutions or other actions of the National Convention. The Labor Party National Committee shall maintain copies of all such rules and shall make them available upon request.

Section 4. Each recognized state Labor Party shall adopt and conduct its affairs in accordance with written rules. Copies of such rules and of any changes or amendments thereto shall be filed with the Labor Party National Committee within thirty days following adoption.

RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION

Section 1. The Labor Party of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, assembled in a Conference on Labor Party Organization and Policy pursuant to resolution adopted by the 2024 Labor Party Call to the Conference hereby adopts for the governance of the Party the Charter attached hereto.
